Dear Mr. Moore,

In reference to your letter of April 29, 1991 requesting the addition of TCLP wastes to your permitted waste list, we consider this to be a Class I modification (see 40 CFR § 270.42). In order to finalize your permit modification request RINCHEM must do the following (but not necessarily in this order):

1. Review your current permit document to determine which aspects of your operating permit need to be modified if these wastes are added (e.g., waste analysis plan, contingency plan, etc.)
2. Prepare page inserts correcting or modifying the respective portions of the permit that will change because of the addition of these wastes.
3. Submit a revised Part A (EPA form 3510-3) to include the newly permitted wastes.
4. Adhere to the procedures delineated in 40 CFR § 270.42(a) for requesting and finalizing a Class I modification.

Note also that according to NMED Hazardous Waste Fee Regulations (EIB/HWFR-1), we are authorized to assess a Permit Modification fee of \$1,000.00. Payment of this fee is not required until a decision has been made on the permit modification request.
