Dear Mr. Horst:

Thank You for responding to our request of changing the Emergency Coordinator and Alternate. You have indicated that this change is considered a class I modification and requires a \$1000.00 fee be paid before the change is made. Although this fee is not unreasonable for the paperwork required, the Rinchem employees assigned to these positions may change several times (internal position reassignments, employee turn-over, etc.), thus causing a repeat fee for a simple change.

To avoid recurring \$1000.00 fees each time a change is required, we propose changing the wording of the Emergency Coordinator List found in section C of Permit Attachment E, Contingency Plan. Rather than naming specific individuals to the positions, the Emergency Coordinator and Alternate positions would be listed as the "positions", and the individuals assigned these positions would be posted throughout the facility. These postings would include the names of the people currently assigned to the positions and their addresses and phone numbers. If changes are required, the posted list could be updated with the newly assigned personnel.

A second issue that we would like your opinion on concerns the crushing of fluorescent bulbs at the Rinchem facility. These bulbs would be brought to the Rinchem facility from several potential generators, crushed on site, and drummed to reduce space requirements for transportation and disposal cost to the generator. It is likely that these bulbs would carry a D009 waste code. Do you consider crushing and re-packaging a material treatment? Also, would it require performing the crushing operations within the facility or should the crushing be done outside the facility premises?


Please advise us on these two issues.
