RE: Current Copy of Part B Contingency Plan

Dear Mr. Levesque:

The Hazardous and Radioactive Materials Bureau (HRMB) of the New Mexico Environment Department (NMED) is in receipt of Rinchem Company, Inc.'s (RCI) current copy of their Part B Contingency Plan (letter dated January 31, 1995).

Upon review of the Contingency Plan which RCI has submitted, the HRMB has determined that this Contingency Plan is not the approved and permitted Contingency Plan that is incorporated into RCI's existing Hazardous Waste Facility Permit, issued January 8, 1988.

This matter is of concern to the HRMB. RCI is authorized to adhere to and distribute only the approved and permitted Contingency Plan (enclosed, Attachment A) that is incorporated into RCI's existing Hazardous Waste Facility Permit, as Permit Attachment E. RCI will not modify the contents of their approved and permitted Contingency Plan without prior approval from HRMB. Modifications to RCI's Part B Contingency Plan must follow the Permit Modification Procedures as specified in 20 NMAC 4.1 Subpart IX, 40 CFR Part 270, Subpart D - Changes to Permit. The only modifications which may be made to RCI's Part B Contingency Plan, outside of the formal permit modification procedures, are updates to the Emergency Coordinator List, Table CP-1.

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Enclosed (Attachment B) please find a copy of RCI's current copy of their Part B Contingency Plan submitted by RCI, letter dated January 31, 1995 and received by the HRMB on February 13, 1995. The following discrepancies have been noted:

- 1) Page 5, Paragraph 2: A new paragraph has been added.
- 2) Page 5, Paragraph 4: The Class I Permit Modification of August 1994, is not incorporated into the Contingency Plan.
- 3) Page 5, Paragraph 4: The first sentence of this paragraph has not been completed. The remainder of the sentence (i.e. "... names, addresses or phone numbers of the emergency coordinator list.") has been omitted.
- 4) Page 6 & 7, Table CP-2: Table CP-2 should not be blocked. The Bernalillo County Sheriff's Office, Chemtrec, and the Poison Control Center have been listed twice (once on page 6 and once on page 7).
