RE: Request for an extension on our 10 day storage limit for waste at our facility.

Dear Ms. Walker:

On January 12, 1995 Rinchem was notified by ENSCO in El Dorado, AR (TSDF) that they will be shut down until January 23, 1995 due to a brick failure in the afterburner unit. All shipments of waste into their facility has been cancelled. At this time we have several waste streams stored at our warehouse for ENSCO which will exceed our 10 day storage limit due to this shutdown. Three generators have waste stored here for shipment which will exceed the 10 day limit. The 1st generator is the Albuquerque Technical Vocational Institute (EPA # NMD075754036). Their waste was picked up 1/3/95. Includes two 30-gallon polys and three 5-gallon polys. The 2nd generator is United Nuclear (EPA# NMD030443503). Their waste was picked up 1/5/95. They have seven 55-gallon drums, seven 30-gallon polys and one 85-gallon drum. The 3rd generator is General Electric Aircraft (EPA# NMD052684578). Their waste was picked up on 1/12/95. They have one 5-gallon pail.

Please let me know if we can have an extension on the storage limit due to the above circumstances. If you would like more information please contact me at 505/345-3655.
