

NOTICE OF INTENT TO ISSUE A PERMIT FOR A CONTAINER STORAGE UNIT

The State of New Mexico is authorized to operate a hazardous waste management program in lieu of the Federal program for the Resource Conservation and Recovery Act (RCRA) in effect prior to the enactment of the Hazardous and Solid Waste Amendments of 1984 (HSWA). The HSWA impose additional requirements on hazardous waste management facilities. The State of New Mexico received additional authorization for the requirements of HSWA effective January 2, 1996.

Under authority of the New Mexico Hazardous Waste Act NMSA 1978 §74-4-1 *et. seq.* (Repl.Pamp. 1993) as amended, 1989, and the New Mexico Hazardous Waste Management Regulations (20 NMAC 4.1, Effective November 30, 1995), the New Mexico Environment Department (NMED) can issue, renew, revoke, suspend or deny, Operating Permits, except 40 CFR §264, Subpart CC, Organic Air Emissions for Tanks, Surface Impoundments, and Containers. NMED and EPA will jointly issue, and enforce the requirements of Subpart CC. When NMED receives authorization from EPA for Subpart CC, NMED will be solely responsible for enforcement of the requirements.. The NMED received a Permit renewal application submitted by **Rinchem Company, Inc., EPA I.D. Number NMD002208627**, for a Subtitle C Container Storage Facility.

The Administrative Record for this draft Permit consists of the draft Permit, a fact sheet, and related correspondence.

Any person who wishes to comment on the draft Permit or to request a public hearing should submit written comments and requests, along with the commentor's name and address, to the Santa Fe address. Requests for a public hearing shall state the nature of the issues proposed to be raised in the hearing and the name and address of the commentor. Only comments and/or requests received on or before **May 31, 2001** will be considered. The NMED will provide a thirty (30) day notice of a public hearing, if scheduled.

The NMED must ensure that the approved draft Permit is consistent with the New Mexico Hazardous Waste Management Regulations for Permits. All written comments submitted on the draft Permit will be considered in formulating a final decision and may cause the draft Permit to be modified. The NMED will notify Rinchem Company, Inc., and each person who submitted a written comment during the public comment period of the final decision.

After consideration of all the written public comments received, the NMED will issue, or modify and issue the Container Storage Operational Permit. If the NMED modifies and issues the Permit, Rinchem Company, Inc., shall be provided by mail a detailed written statement of reasons for the modification. A copy of the modified Permit will be mailed to Rinchem Company, Inc.

FACILITY NAME: Rinchem Company, Inc.

EPA I.D. NUMBER: NMD002208627

FACILITY LOCATION: The Rinchem Company, Inc. (RCI) Container Storage Facility (**the Facility**) is located at 6133 Edith Boulevard in the Northeastern quadrant of the City of Albuquerque in Bernalillo County, New Mexico on Latitude 35° 8' 39" North and on Longitude 106° 37' 43" West.

ACTIVITIES: Storage and Transfer of Hazardous Waste

FACILITY PURPOSE: The objective of the work to be conducted under this renewed Permit is to continue to accept and store off-site hazardous waste before its transfer to a permitted treatment or disposal facility.

FACILITY DESCRIPTION: The RCI Container Storage and transfer Facility consists of 23,000 square foot warehouse and office, loading/unloading dock, a back dock, and two rainwater containment areas. The whole Facility is situated on 2 acres of land, 600 feet west of Edith Boulevard.
