

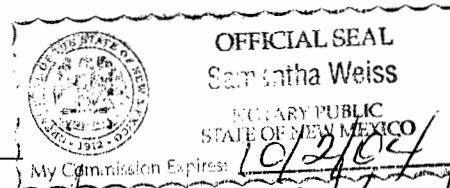



**NOTICE OF INTENT TO ISSUE A
PERMIT FOR A CONTAINER STOR-
AGE FACILITY**

The State of New Mexico is authorized to operate a hazardous waste management program in lieu of the Federal program for the Resource Conservation and Recovery Act (RCRA) in effect prior to the enactment of the Hazardous and Solid Waste Amendments of 1984 (HSWA). The HSWA impose additional requirements on hazardous waste management facilities. The State of New Mexico received additional authorization for the requirements of HSWA effective January 2, 1996.

Under authority of the New Mexico Hazardous Waste Act NMSA 1978 §74-4-1 et. seq. (Repl.Pamp. 2000) as amended, 1989, and the New Mexico Hazardous Waste Management Regulations (20.4.1 NMAC, Effective June 14, 2000), the New Mexico Environment Department (NMED) can issue, renew, revoke, suspend or deny, Operating Permits. NMED received a Permit renewal application submitted by **Rinchem Company, Inc., EPA I.D. Number NMD002208627**, for a Subtitle C Hazardous Waste Container Storage Facility.

The Administrative Record for this draft Permit consists of the draft Permit, a fact sheet, and related correspondence.

Any person who wishes to comment on the draft Permit or to request a public hearing should submit written comments and requests, along with the commentor's name and address, to the contact person at the above Santa Fe address. Requests for a public hearing shall provide: (1) a clear and concise factual statement of the nature and scope of the interest of the person requesting the hearing; (2) the name and address of all persons whom the requester represents; (3) a statement of any objections to the draft permit, including specific references to the permit condition; and (4) a statement of the issues which such persons propose to raise for consideration at the hearing. Only comments and/or requests received on or before **January 28, 2002** will be considered. NMED will provide a thirty (30) day notice of a public hearing, if scheduled.

NMED must ensure that the approved draft Permit is consistent with the New Mexico Hazardous Waste Management Regulations for Permits. All written comments submitted on the draft Permit will be considered in formulating a final decision and may cause the draft Permit to be modified. NMED will respond in writing to all public comments. This response shall:

(a) specify which provisions, if any, of the draft permit have been changed in the final permit decision, and the reasons for the change; and

(b) briefly describe and respond to all public comments on the draft permit or the permit application raised during the public comment period or public hearing.

The Secretary will make the final permit decision publicly available and shall notify the applicants by certified mail. All persons presenting written comments, and who requested notification in writing shall be notified of the decision by first-class regular mail. The Secretary's decision shall constitute a final agency decision and may be appealed as provided by the Hazardous Waste Act.

After consideration of all the written public comments received, NMED will issue, or modify and issue the Container Storage Operational Permit. If the NMED modifies and issues the Permit, Rinchem Company, Inc., shall be provided by mail a detailed written statement of reasons for the modification. A copy of the modified Permit will be mailed to Rinchem Company, Inc.
