Dear Ms. Raven:

The New Mexico Environment Department (NMED) has received the above-referenced request for permit changes dated March 11, 2005, from Rinchem Company, Inc., (hereafter, **Rinchem**). In your letter you informed NMED to update the Container Storage operating permit Emergency Coordinator list because of changes in Rinchem personnel.

Following review of the your request for the update, HWB has determined that the requested change to the Contingency Plan constitutes an administrative change to the permit and is a Class 1 permit modification, not requiring prior approval from NMED. This is specified under the New Mexico Hazardous Waste Management Regulations 20.4.1.900 NMAC, incorporating 40 CFR 270.42(a)(2).


However, Rinchem is required to provide NMED a permit modification request to your current operating permit on the subject change(s). Upon receipt of your written request, NMED will send you a mailing list, which you must use to inform all persons on that list within 90 calendar days from the date you receive that list. This is in accordance with the requirements of 20.4.1.900 NMAC, incorporating 40 CFR §270.42(a)(ii).
