
The New Mexico Environment Department (NMED) has reviewed Advanced Chemical Transport/Treatment, Inc.'s (ACT's) documents, which indicate their method of complying with the financial requirements (FRs) specified at 40 CFR § 264.140 through 40 CFR § 264.151, for operation of Rinchem Company Inc.'s (RNCM's) permitted Container Storage Facility located at 6133 Edith Boulevard NE, Albuquerque. The FRs were required from ACT as provided in the Department's letter dated November 28, 2011.

Following review of ACT's documents that include Certificates of Liability Insurance, the Certificate of Acknowledgement, the Original Corporate Authorization and Incumbency Certificate containing the corporate seal of Comerica Bank and Trust, N.A., (the Trustee), and the approval from the Office of the Comptroller of the Currency Administration of National Banks (Washington, D.C) permitting Comerica Bank to engage in fiduciary and investment activities, NMED hereby approves the transfer of financial responsibility from Rinchem to ACT. This approval is effective upon ACT's receipt of this letter of approval.
