Dear Ms. Harsono and Ms. Gorgone:

The New Mexico Environment Department (NMED, the Department) has reviewed the "*Request for Class 1 Permit Modification for Part B Permit – NMD002208627: Update of Emergency Coordinator and Alternate List for Contingency Plan in Part B Permit*" submitted by Advanced Chemical Transport/Treatment, Inc. (ACT), (the Permittee) dated November 5, 2012. In the submittal ACT requested NMED to Update the Emergency Coordinator and Alternate List for Contingency Plan in its current operating Permit to reflect current personnel responsibilities and contact information and to also maintain compliance with requirements of the current Container storage Facility operating Permit. In connection with that the Permittees requested the revision of Table H-1 of Permit Attachment H, Contingency Plan, by updating the Emergency Coordinator information. This additional information was mentioned by the Permittees in a November 6, 2012 e-mail to NMED staff.

Following review of your request for the update, NMED has determined that the requested change to the Contingency Plan constitutes an administrative change to the permit and is a Class 1 permit modification, not requiring prior approval from NMED. This is specified under the New Mexico Hazardous Waste Management Regulations 20.4.1.900 NMAC, incorporating 40 CFR 270.42(a)(2).

The New Mexico Hazardous Waste Management Fee Regulations 20.4.2 NMAC require assessment of fees when administrative review of a document is complete. Payment of the fees is normally due within sixty (60) calendar days from the date that you receive the invoice.

However, ACT has already submitted the fees prior to Agency written approval of the Permit modification. NMED hereby acknowledges receipt of the \$500.00 from the Permittees to be applied as fees for the Permit modification. The Department has attached an invoice to this letter for your records.

NMED advises the Permittees that in future, money be sent to the Department only following the modification class determination and receipt of an invoice from the Department.


NMED hereby approves the Advanced Chemical Transport's (the Permittee's) Class 1 Permit Modification request without prior approval for the Hazardous Waste Operating Permit for the Container Storage Facility, dated November 5, 2012. This approval is effective upon ACT's receipt of this letter of approval.

Enclosed is a clean copy of the Emergency Coordinator list (Table H-1) that the Permittees must incorporate into the current operating Permit's Permit Attachment H (page 3 of 9).

Further, the Permittees must send a notice of the Permit modification to all persons on the Facility mailing list maintained by the Department. The Department will send you, electronically, the list concurrently with this letter of approval. This notification must be made within 90 calendar days after the Permittees receive this approval letter, as required by 40 CFR § 270.42(a)(ii), incorporated by 20.4.1.900 NMAC.
