Advanced Chemical Treatment, Inc (ACT Treatment) would like to request a Class 1 Permit Modification to the Part B TSDF renewal application located at 6133 Edith Blvd. NE – EPA ID #NMD002208627 to address the following items:

1. Removal of adjacent yard located at 6141 Edith Blvd. to Part B Permit

ACT Transport has moved to their own facility and therefore we are not leasing the yard from Riccobene located at 6141 Edith Blvd. NE, Albuquerque, NM 87107. This property was adjacent to the PART B TSDF and was used for storage of equipment such as trucks, trailers, and roll-off bins. It was at no point used for permanent storage of waste, nor was it ever used for any type of Part B Operations. The permit is now fully fenced and appropriate signage is in place. Please refer to the revised Figure 6 (Facility Layout) of the Permit Renewal Application included with this letter.

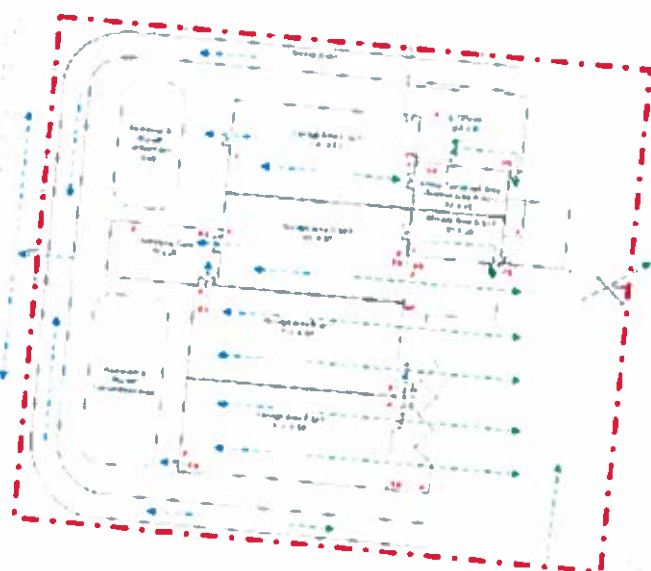
