Dear Mr. Smith:

The New Mexico Environment Department (NMED) has reviewed the ACT Treatment, Inc. (Applicant or Permittee) Resource Conservation and Recovery Act (RCRA) Part B Permit Renewal Application dated July 19, 2018, as required under the New Mexico Hazardous Waste Management Regulations 20.4.1 and 20.4.2 NMAC. The application is for renewal of the Permittee's RCRA Permit for hazardous waste storage and for hazardous waste treatment at their facility located at 6137 Edith Boulevard, N.E. Albuquerque, New Mexico.

After reviewing the permit application, NMED has determined the application contains sufficient information to be considered administratively complete.

The New Mexico Hazardous Waste Management Fee Regulations 20.4.2 NMAC require assessment of fees when administrative review of a document is complete. The Applicant was previously invoiced for hazardous waste container storage. NMED considers the proposed treatment operations to be treatment in containers for the purpose of invoicing. NMED has attached an invoice for the hazardous waste treatment operations to this letter.

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
Payment is due within sixty (60) calendar days from the date that you receive the invoice in accordance with 20.4.2.301.C NMAC. If you disagree with the fee assessed, you may notify the NMED in writing, at the address above, of the intent to appeal the invoice under the provisions of 20.4.2.302.A NMAC no less than seven days prior to the payment due date.

If payment is by check, then you must provide the invoice number on the check. If payment is transmitted electronically, then you must submit a letter to Mr. Brian Holton, NMED Hazardous Waste Bureau, indicating the invoice number, payment amount, and the assessed activity prior to transferring funds. Should the Permittee need to request an extension of the sixty-day period the request must be submitted at least seven days prior to the payment due date.

Upon receipt of the fees NMED will begin reviewing the permit application for technical adequacy.
