



I certify that the two sewage lagoons at this facility are in compliance with all applicable New Mexico ground-water monitoring requirements which are part of New Mexico's authorized hazardous waste program under Section 3006 of the Resource Conservation and Recovery Act (RCRA). I also certify that Cannon Air Force Base is a federal facility that is exempt from state and federal financial responsibility requirements by virtue of New Mexico Hazardous Waste Management Regulation-2, Part II, Sec 206c.3.a(3) and 40 C.F.R. Sec 265.140(c).
