RE: COMPLIANCE AGREEMENT WELLS - REPLY TO JUNE 28, 1991
LETTER

Dear Colonel Chapman:


In reference to your June 28, 1991 letter regarding installation of the two remaining wells pursuant to Items 2 and 3 of the referenced agreement, the Hazardous and Radioactive Waste Bureau (HRWB) conditionally accepts the Cannon Air Force Bases (CAFB) proposal for construction of the remaining RCRA wells, subject to the following conditions:

1. The two proposed wells, "L" and "M", are located due north of existing well "I", i.e., along a north-west orientation. The wells should be located along a generally southeast-northwest trending line, i.e., along a line which is perpendicular to the hydraulic gradient.
2. HRWB assumes that since the proposed wells "L" and "M" are to be drilled sequentially, the same dry-drilling technique will be used in the installation of each well.

If these conditions are acceptable to CAFB, CAFB may commence well installation without further approvals from HRWB.
