Cannon AFB is submitting this progress report for November 1991 in accordance with the Landfill 5 Compliance Agreement. Actions which were taken during the month are described below.

On 15 Nov 91 representatives from Cannon AFB, the Corps of Engineers and the U.S. Geological Survey (USGS) met in Santa Fe to discuss both the Landfill 5 Compliance Agreement and the Compliance Order. At the meeting the NMED agreed to extend the timetable for the installation of the two groundwater monitoring wells. The NMED also agreed to work with the USGS to determine if the first well could be drilled wet in conjunction with the use of a neutron probe. Once this decision is made we will begin installing the wells.
