Extension of Order Deadlines for Well Installation

Dear Colonel Chapman:

Due to the difficulties experienced by Cannon Air Force Base in locating appropriate monitoring well drilling equipment for "dry drilling" either monitoring wells "L" or "M", the Hazardous and Radioactive Materials Bureau (HRMB) by this letter extends the deadline for the drilling these monitoring wells to January 31, 1992.

Additional dates drawn from the subject Agreement and adjusted for extensions granted by NMED are:

1. All RCRA wells emplaced to monitor the RCRA landfill must be sampled by February 17, 1992. Pursuant to paragraph V.B.5 of the subject Agreement, CAFB shall begin a determination of groundwater quality as set forth in HWMR-5, 40 CFR Section 265, subpart F.
2. CAFB must certify to NMED in writing no later than March 2, 1991, that wells L and M have been drilled as per agreement with NMED, including continuous coring to the uppermost aquifer in either well L or M.
3. CAFB must submit as-built diagrams to NMED detailing the construction of wells L and M by March 23, 1992.

HRMB will not grant further extensions for the fulfillment of terms of the Agreement unless pursuant to Section IX of the Agreement.
