RE: Cannon AFB Phase I RFI Work Plan for Landfill 1 Investigation

Dear Mr. Davis

On 27 Apr 92 we telefaxed a copy of a memo from Woodward-Clyde, our contractor for the RCRA facility investigation for landfills one and two, to Mr. Richard Mayer of your office. The memo concerned the investigation at Landfill One. The investigation included a geophysical investigation using electromagnetic methods and the drilling of 32 geotechnical soil borings in an attempt to delineate the boundaries of landfill one.

The investigation produced no evidence of a landfill in the area of concern. Later on 27 Apr 92, Mr. Mayer spoke to Mr. Bruce Hale of our Environmental Office and informed him that he would require no further investigation of the landfill one area, because the current information appeared to be sufficient to indicate the absence of a landfill. In accordance with Mr. Mayer's request, we will also submit the geophysical data in the final RFI report on landfills one and two.
