





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Re: Summary of Drilling and Development of Well L

Dear Mr Garcia

We have received the enclosed report titled Summary of Drilling and Development of Well L from the USGS. The report consists of the personnel log documentation during drilling and development, a lithologic log, a monitoring well identification report, a well construction diagram inspected and signed by a professional engineer, a chemical analysis of the drilling mud at the end of the drilling, the geophysical logs of the well and photographs of the cores recovered during the drilling.

Our review of the compliance agreement shows that the only remaining item required to fulfill the agreement is the submission of a map of the landfill which is required by the as built report. This map is to show all monitoring wells, the boundary of the landfill, the boundaries of the cells, a north arrow, and scale. We are developing a scope of work which requires that the map submitted to your office on 13 Jun 91 be updated with the locations of wells L and M and that the exact boundaries of cell three (as found during the 14 - 17 Jan 92 investigation) be surveyed and shown on the same drawing. We expect the final survey and drawing to be submitted to your office by 15 Sep 92.
