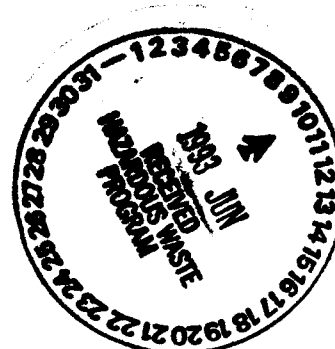

RE: Modification of Storage Facility Permit

Dear Mr Horst

Cannon AFB is continually working to improve our hazardous waste and hazardous material management practices. In the efforts to keep pace with base expansion, we are realizing some necessary changes to items covered in our current Resource Conservation and Recovery Act (RCRA) Part B permit.

When funding becomes available we intend to conduct a full review of the permit and submit a complete modification package. We realize your 120 day review requirements, and will coordinate this submittal with your office at the appropriate time.

Of immediate concern is our desire to move the less than 90 day accumulation point associated with building 680 to building 624. Building 624 will remain an unused less than 90 day accumulation point until we have fully reviewed our requirements. The site at building 680 will become a satellite accumulation point for the sole use of building 680 personnel. The site drawing at Atch 1 helps delineate these site locations.

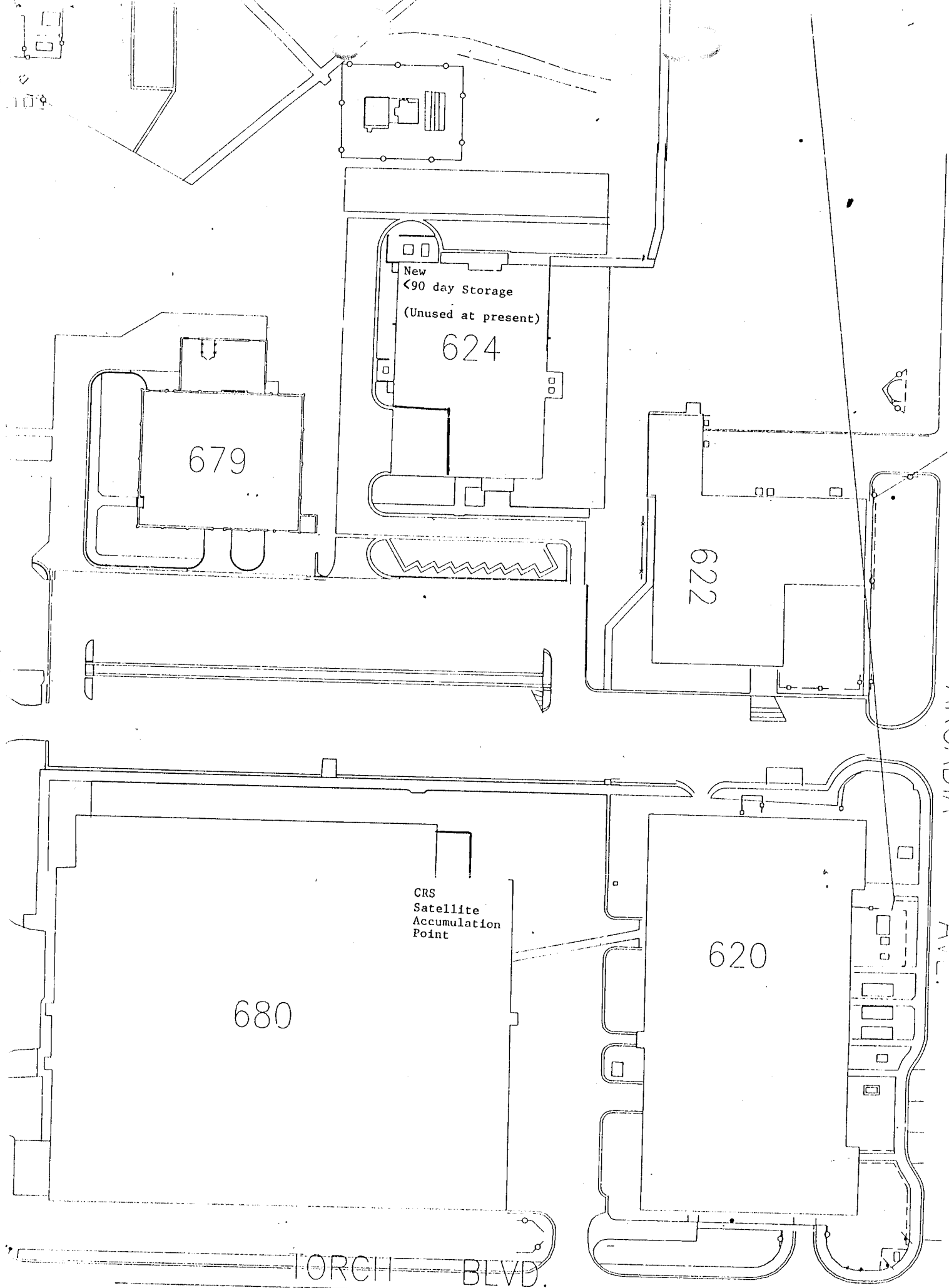
We are considering revising our operations to utilize a single less than 90 day accumulation point for the base to consolidate operations. At this time, our operations are still under review.
