Dear Ms. Hoditschek

This is the first quarter 1994 (January - March) progress report required per Section D of Module IV of the November 14, 1989 Hazardous and Solid Waste Amendments (HSWA) Permit for the RFI at Landfill No. 5/SWMU No. 113.

Significant events regarding Landfill 5/SWMU No. 113 at Cannon AFB during January-March 1994 were:

- a. The submission of our NOD response for the Phase I Draft Work Plan to the New Mexico Environment Department (NMED) on February 16, 1994. We are expecting a reply to this NOD response from your agency during the second quarter (April-June 1994).
- b. Although this is not a HSWA issue, we would like to inform you that in March a contract was awarded to Engineering-Science Inc. to rewrite the Post-Closure Care Plan for Cell No. 3 at Landfill 5.

Projected activities for Landfill No. 5/SWMU No. 113 at Cannon AFB for the next quarter (April-June 1994) are:

- a. Cannon AFB anticipates approval of the RFI Draft Work Plan during the second quarter of 1994. The field work will begin upon formal written approval of the Work Plan.
- b. The Post-Closure Care Plan for Cell 3 at Landfill 5 written by Engineering-Science Inc. will be delivered to your agency.
