This is the second quarter 1994 (April - June) progress report required per Section D of Module IV of the November 14, 1989 Hazardous and Solid Waste Amendments Permit for the RFI at Landfill No. 5/SWMU No. 113.

Significant events regarding Landfill 5/SWMU No. 113 at Cannon AFB during April - June 1994 were:

- a. New Mexico Environment Department 's (NMED) comments on our Notice of Deficiency response for the Phase I Draft Work Plan was received by Cannon AFB on April 21, 1994.
- b. A meeting was held in Santa Fe on May 19, 1994 to discuss Cannon AFB's responses to NMED's comments. This meeting was attended by representatives from NMED, US Army Corps of Engineers, Woodward-Clyde Consultants, and Cannon AFB.
- c. The Post-Closure Care Plan for Cell No. 3 at Landfill 5 was submitted to NMED on April 11, 1994.

Projected activities for Landfill No. 5/SWMU No. 113 for the next quarter (July - September 1994) are:

- a. Cannon AFB anticipates approval of the RFI Draft Work Plan during the third quarter of 1994. Field work will be initiated upon receipt of written approval from NMED.

b. Cannon AFB expects to receive NMED's comments on the Landfill 5 Cell 3 Post Closure Care Plan.
