Dear General Guth:

The Hazardous and Radioactive Material Bureau (HRMB) of the New Mexico Environment Department (NMED) has not received any information concerning the permit modification(s) that Cannon Air Force Base (CAFB) proposed during a telephone conversation with HRMB staff. NMED for planning purposes request CAFB propose a timetable for receipt of this material. Please submit this information to HRMB within ten days of receipt of this letter.

The permit modification procedures HRMB follows are found in the New Mexico Hazardous Waste Management Regulations 20 NMAC 4.1 Subpart IX, 40 CFR Part 270.42 for changes requested by the Permittee. An efficient approach for CAFB to follow in preparing for permit modification requests would be to review the above referenced regulations against the operational or other facility changes planned.


Proposed modifications are to be sent to HRMB for an initial class analysis. The modifications requested must specify the exact changes proposed to be made in the permit conditions and permit attachments. All supporting technical information should be included. Please provide this on a Wordperfect 5.2, (3.5") disk.
