In response to your letter of 24 Jan 95, the Part B permit modification is now being reviewed internally. The complete package will be mailed to you on or before 27 Feb 95.

The base has several projects actively investigating the presence of RCRA regulated hazardous materials that resulted from previous disposal practices and/or spillage. The ongoing projects consist of RCRA Facility Investigations, and the potential for future RCRA Corrective Measures Studies at designated Solid Waste Management Units.

Descriptions of the aforementioned RCRA Facility Investigations are evolving rapidly as new data becomes available. Accurate descriptions of these RCRA projects change on an annual, if not more frequent basis. Documentation pertaining to these ongoing RCRA activities is prepared by the base's Installation Restoration Program (IRP) and exists in documents such as *The Management Action Plan for Cannon AFB* and subsequent documents. It is not the intent of the Part B permit modification to include the previous or current IRP data; this would only duplicate existing documents, causing the Part B permit to be updated annually or more frequently. Your written concurrence or guidance on this issue would be appreciated.
