

Dear Ms. Hoditschek

We are providing you the fourth quarter 1994 (Oct-Dec) progress report required per Section D of Module IV of the 14 Nov 89 Hazardous and Solid Waste Amendments Permit for the RCRA Facility Investigation (RFI) at Landfill No. 5/SWMU No. 113.

Significant events regarding Landfill 5/SWMU No. 113 at Cannon AFB during Oct-Dec 94 were:

- a. Mr. S. Mukherjee, Cannon AFB Project Manager, resigned and left Cannon AFB in Oct 94.
- b. The result of the Aug 94 groundwater sampling of Landfill 5 monitoring wells was received in Nov and forwarded to NMED and EPA (17 Nov 94 letter).

Projected activities for Landfill No. 5/SWMU No. 113 at Cannon AFB for the next quarter (Jan-Mar 95) are:

- a. Field work is expected to begin on the Landfill No. 5 Phase I Investigation. A meeting to review geophysical and soil-gas survey results will occur in late Mar to determine suitable soil boring locations.
- b. Cannon AFB expects to receive comments from NMED on the Landfill No. 5 Post Closure Care Plan.
- c. A replacement Cannon AFB Project Manager will be hired.

d. The New NMED Project Managers will visit Cannon AFB in late Feb to participate in the Rational National Standards Initiative Meeting.
