The New Mexico Hazardous and Radioactive Materials Bureau (HRMB) has received a copy of the modified pages of the approved draft of the RFI Phase I work plan on February 14, 1995. HRMB has reviewed the aforementioned modified pages and has determined that they are adequate. It is the understanding of HRMB that the final draft of the above-referenced RFI Phase I work plan will incorporate procedures and information pertaining to Cell 3 of Landfill 5, as per discussion with your staff on June 14, 1995. In addition, HRMB has reviewed CAFB's draft Geophysical Survey and Soil Gas Survey Technical Reports (received April 28, 1995) and approves CAFB's recommended soil boring locations shown on a map submitted to HRMB on June 5, 1995. CAFB may start work immediately on the soil borings as discussed in the draft RFI Work Plan.
