On May 1, 1995, in a letter to Cannon Air Force Base (CAFB) regarding Cell 3 Landfill 5, HRMB provided CAFB with the option to submit a post closure care permit application or coordinate closure activities with the current RCRA facility investigation.

After meeting with CAFB on June 6th, 1995 concerning the regulatory direction and clean up strategy associated with the permitted unit (Cell 3), NMED has determined that CAFB must pursue a post closure permit application for the above mentioned cell.

At this time CAFB has not submitted a post closure care permit application and this letter will serve as the formal call in of this document. This post closure care permit application must address the Notice of Deficiency that was issued to CAFB on February 28th, 1995. HRMB requests the post closure care permit application be submitted within (30) days receipt of this letter. Failure to submit this permit application can result in enforcement action and or fines.
