Dear Mr. Weidler

This is to inform you of recent construction on the site of Solid Waste Management Unit (SWMU) 108, Explosive Ordnance Disposal (EOD) Training Area. This SWMU is included in the Cannon AFB Draft RCRA Facility Investigation (RFI) Appendix II SWMUs Phase II report which we sent you for review and approval in Apr 95. This RFI report recommends "No Further Action" for this site.

To improve safety and meet the requirements of Air Force Manual 91-201, Explosive Safety Standards, a barricade was constructed in the middle of SWMU 108 (see attached project drawings). This barricade will allow continued EOD proficiency training. The construction of the barricade was completed in Jan 96. The footings for the concrete barricade are buried eight inches in the silty clay surface soil. The disturbed soil was left on site as an earthen berm. The RFI report (page 12-4) indicates that there were no laboratory contaminants in this "near-surface" soil.


