Dear Colonel Ard:

This letter is to provide written confirmation of Hazardous and Radioactive Materials Bureau (HRMB) approval of an extension of the time period allowed for Cannon Air Force Base (CAFB) to respond to a letter of approval with required modifications (NOD) sent by HRMB to CAFB and dated December 19, 1996.

The NOD requires that CAFB revise the Workplan within 30 days of receipt of the NOD. I approved a ten day extension of that period by phone today. This letter confirms that CAFB is now required to submit the revised Workplan to HRMB within 40 days of CAFB's receipt of the NOD.
