The Hazardous and Radioactive Materials Bureau (HRMB) of the New Mexico Environment Department (NMED) has reviewed for technical adequacy the above-referenced Report, as required under the New Mexico Hazardous Waste Management Regulations. The Report is dated September 8, 1997.

After reviewing the Report, the HRMB has found the Report to be technically adequate and approves the Report. The Site may be removed from the listing of SWMU's in the HSWA module of your RCRA Permit if you submit a Class 3 permit modification request for removal of the Site and that request is approved HRMB.

To comply with solid waste asbestos regulations, all ACM chips exposed on the ground surface now and in the future must be removed and disposed of at a construction and demolition or asbestos landfill.
