The RCRA Permits Management Program (RPMP) of the New Mexico Environment Department (NMED) has reviewed for technical adequacy the above-referenced Report, as required under the New Mexico Hazardous Waste Management Regulations. The Report is dated May, 1998.

After reviewing the Report, the RPMP has found the Report to be technically adequate and approves the Report. However, the RPMP has determined that a Corrective Measures Study must be submitted to determine the most effective means of reducing TPH levels in soil to under 1,000 mg/kg, the RPMP cleanup level for TPH. TPH was detected at the site at up to 14,400 mg/kg.
