The Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) has completed a review of the Corrective Measure Implementation Work Plan For SWMU 31 (AGE Maintenance Pad) and SWMU 77 (Civil Engineering Container Storage Area) at Cannon Air Force Base, Clovis, New Mexico.

This is a Voluntary Corrective Action of two low priority Solid Waste Management Units (SWMUs) to achieve closure per the Base Resource Conservation and Recovery Act (RCRA) Permit.

The New Mexico Environment Department (NMED) Hazardous and Radioactive Materials Bureau determined that the planned excavation at Site 1 and Site 2 (SWMU 77) was not necessary, since detections were not significant.
