Dear Colonel Clary:

This letter serves as Hazardous and Radioactive Materials Bureau (HRMB) approval of a ninety (90) day extension to the due date for submittal of Cannon Air Force Base's (CAFB) RCRA Permit Application. The Application is now due on July 18, 1999.

Under 40 CFR §270.10(h), CAFB must submit a new application for renewal of its RCRA Permit at least 180 days before the expiration date of its existing Permit, unless an extension is granted by HRMB. Under 40 CFR §270.51, the conditions of the expired Permit remain in force until the effective date of the new Permit, if CAFB submits a complete and timely application for the new Permit. CAFB's existing Permit expires on October 16, 1999, and the Application was due on April 19, 1999.

If CAFB complies with the July 18, 1999 submittal date, the terms of the existing Permit will remain in effect until issuance of the new Permit.
