This letter is the combined second and third quarters (Apr-Sep 99) Progress Report required by Sec D, Module IV of the Cannon Air Force Base Resource Conservation and Recovery Act (RCRA) Part B Permit, Hazardous and Solid Waste Amendments Section. Two quarters have been combined due to no report being submitted in the second quarter because of the absence of the program manager.

Activities for the RCRA Corrective Action Program (RCAP) and other significant permit activities for the quarters are included as follows:

a. Cannon AFB sent to the New Mexico Environment Department (NMED) and the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency the final site inspection report for Areas of Concern E, F, G and H.

b. Cannon AFB held a Restoration Advisory Board meeting in Portales.

Projected RCAP Activities for the fourth quarter:

a. Cannon AFB will submit to NMED the final semi-annual monitoring report for Landfill 25 Solid Waste Management Unit (SWMU) 97.

b. Cannon AFB will submit to NMED the groundwater monitoring report for the sewage lagoons and Landfill 5 for samples collected 2-5 Mar 99.

c. Cannon AFB will submit to NMED the annual summary report for assessment monitoring for 1998 sampling events at Landfill 3 (SWMU 105), Landfill 4 (SWMU 104) and Landfill 25 (SWMU 97)
