This letter is the first quarter (Jan-Mar 00) Progress Report as required per Section D, Module IV, of the Cannon Air Force Base Resource Conservation and Recovery Act (RCRA), Part B Permit, Hazardous and Solid Waste Amendments Section.

Activities for the RCRA Corrective Action Program (RCAP) and other significant permit activities for the first quarter are as follows:

- a. Cannon AFB held a Restoration Advisory Board meeting in Feb 00.
- b. Cannon AFB submitted a Corrective Measures Study (CMS) Workplan for closure of the sewage lagoons Solid Waste Management Unit (SWMU) 101.
- c. Cannon AFB submitted page changes to the CMS Workplan at SD-11 (SWMUs 86-90).
- d. Cannon AFB submitted groundwater monitoring results for sampling taken at Landfill 5 and the sewage lagoons in Aug 99.
- e. Cannon AFB sent representatives to the RCRA partnering meeting in Feb 00.
- f. Cannon AFB previously submitted the final Corrective Measures Report for 19 Appendix II and III Oil Water Separators in the fourth quarter of CY 99.
- g. Cannon AFB has not yet received the report for annual bioventing assessment at SWMU 70 for 1999. It will be forwarded when received.

Projected RCAP activities for the second quarter of 2000 are as follows:

- a. Cannon AFB will submit Volume I of No Further Action proposals to NMED to remove 30 SWMUs from the RCRA Part B permit.
- b. Cannon AFB will hold a Restoration Advisory Board meeting in May 00.
- c. Cannon AFB will send representatives to the May 00 RCRA partnering meeting.
- d. Cannon AFB will submit the closure report for the demolition of Facility 244 (AOC I).
- e. Cannon AFB will submit a basewide Health and Safety Plan for the CMS at SWMU 101 the sewage lagoons; perform a surface cleanup at Landfill 25; and CMS at Fire Training Area 4.
