This letter is the second quarter (Apr-Jun 00) Progress Report as required per Section D, Module IV, of the Cannon Air Force Base Resource Conservation and Recovery Act (RCRA), Part B Permit, Hazardous and Solid Waste Amendments Section.

Activities for the RCRA Corrective Action Program (RCAP) and other significant permit activities for the second quarter are as follows:

- a. Cannon AFB held a Restoration Advisory Board meeting in May 00.
- b. Cannon AFB sent a representative to the May 00 RCRA partnering meeting.
- c. Cannon AFB completed the field work for the Corrective Measures Study at the sewage lagoons (SWMU 101).
- d. Cannon AFB held a kick off meeting with their contractors for a Voluntary Corrective Action at Landfill 25 (SWMU 97).
- e. Cannon AFB hand delivered to NMED the Corrective Measures Study for SWMUs 31, 48 A, 77, and 127.

Projected RCAP activities for the third quarter of 2000 are as follows:

- a. Cannon AFB will submit No Further Action proposals to NMED to remove approximately 60 SWMUs from the RCRA Part B permit. Last quarter we anticipated sending Volume I of NFA proposals to NMED but the project was somewhat delayed and we will submit all the the proposals in one package.



- b. Cannon AFB will send a representative to the Jul 00 partnering meeting.
- c. Cannon AFB will submit the closure report for the demolition of Facility 244 (AOC I). It was anticipated at the last report that we would forward this report in the second quarter but the report was delayed and will be forwarded in the third quarter.
- d. Cannon AFB will submit a basewide Health and Safety Plan for the CMS at the sewage lagoons (SWMU 101), voluntary corrective action at Landfill 25 (SWMU 97), and CMS at Fire Training Area 4 (SWMUs 109-112). It was anticipated that this Health and Safety Plan would be submitted last quarter but it was delayed and will be submitted this quarter.
- e. Cannon AFB will submit the annual evaluation of bioventing at SWMU 70 which was done in 1999.
- f. Cannon AFB will submit the groundwater monitoring report for the sewage lagoons (SWMU 101) and Landfill 5 (SWMU 113) which were sampled in Feb and Mar 2000.
- g. Cannon AFB will submit a workplan for the surface cleanup at Landfill 25 to NMED.
- h. Cannon AFB will submit a workplan for the Corrective Measures Study at Fire Training Area 4.
