Attached for your information is an affidavit of publication and copy of the newspaper ad published in the Clovis News Journal on 1 Oct 00 giving public notice of the Class 3 Permit Modification. This permit was submitted to the New Mexico Environment Department (NMED), signed by the Wing Commander on 5 Sep and mailed to NMED on 7 Sep 00. Originally the paper published the ad on 12 Sep and left out the Air Force contact person so the ad was printed again on 14 Sep 00 with the correct information as shown in the attached photocopy. Due to some confusion on whether we had met the public notice requirements, we published the ad again on 1 Oct 00 and changed the Public Meeting date to 26 Oct 00. We also gave notice of the permit modification over a local radio station as shown by the enclosed invoice. People on the state interest list were notified by letter.
