This letter is the third quarter (Jul-Sep) Progress Report as required per Section D, Module IV, of the Cannon Air Force Base Resource Conservation and Recovery Act (RCRA) Part B Permit, Hazardous and Solid Waste Amendments Section.

Activities for the RCRA Corrective Action Program (RCAP) and other significant permit activities for the third quarter are as follows:

- a. Cannon AFB sent a representative to the July NMED/DOD Partnering meeting.
- b. Cannon AFB submitted a Class 3 Permit Modification Request to NMED to remove 61 SWMUs, 5 AOCs, and one miscellaneous unit from the RCRA Part B Permit.
- c. Cannon AFB submitted the closure report for the demolition of Facility 244 (AOC I) to NMED.
- d. Cannon AFB submitted the annual evaluation of bioventing at SWMU 70 which was done in 1999 to NMED.
- e. Cannon AFB submitted a work plan for the surface cleanup at Landfill 25 (SWMU 97) to NMED.
- f. Cannon AFB submitted the groundwater monitoring report for the sewage lagoons (SWMU 101) and Landfill 5 (SWMU 113) which were sampled in Feb and Mar 2000.
- g. Cannon AFB commenced field operations on the Landfill 25 surface cleanup during the last week of September.
- h. Cannon AFB decided not to submit the basewide Health and Safety Plan for the CMS

at the sewage lagoons (SWMU 101), voluntary corrective action at Landfill 25 (SWMU97), and CMS at Fire Training Area 4 (SWMUs 109-112) since each work plan has a site specific health and safety plan included.

Projected RCAP activities for the fourth quarter of 2000 are as follows:

- a. Cannon AFB will hold a public meeting on the Class 3 Permit Modification Request and Restoration Advisory Board meeting on 26 Oct 00 at the Civil Engineer Conference Room on Cannon AFB.
- b. Cannon AFB will submit the Corrective Measures Study Report for the Sewage Lagoons (SWMU 101).
- c. Cannon AFB will send a representative to the next NMED/DOD partnering meeting.
- d. Cannon AFB will submit the Corrective Measures Study Report for Fire Training Area 4 (SWMUs 109-112).
