SUBJECT: Delegation of Signature Authority for Environmental and Bioenvironmental  
Correspondence (S/S 27 FW/CC Memo, 7 Jun 00)

1. In order to improve efficiency and timeliness of reports and to meet short suspenses from regulatory agencies, I delegate authority for routine and technical environmental matters to the Base Civil Engineer and Deputy Base Civil Engineer and for routine and technical bioenvironmental matters to the 27th Medical Group Commander. This memorandum is in accordance with 40 CFR 270.11(b) and 40 CFR 122.22(b) that authorize the delegation of authority by the principal executive officer of a federal agency.
2. Routine correspondence is defined as correspondence that does not obligate Cannon or have legal implications. Examples of routine correspondence include laboratory analytical results or the submission of recurring reports that are required under various operating permits, which demonstrate full compliance with permit requirements.
3. I will retain signature authority for priority correspondence addressing new permit requests; notices of violation; open enforcement actions; and policy matters and transmittal reports that indicate noncompliance with permit conditions, or applicable environmental laws and regulations. If there is a question as to the classification of a piece of correspondence, treat it as nonroutine and I will sign it.
4. All correspondence on environmental matters, whether routine or priority, will be coordinated with the Environmental Flight (27 CE/CEV) and Staff Judge Advocate (27 FW/JA) prior to release. All correspondence on bioenvironmental matters, whether routine or priority, will be coordinated with the Bioenvironmental Engineering Flight (27 ADOS/SGGB) prior to release.
5. In accordance with 40 CFR 270.11(b) and 40 CFR 122.22(b), I have informed the Secretary of the New Mexico Environment Department and the Regional Administrator of the US Environmental Protection Agency of the delegation authority.
