

This letter is the fourth quarter (Oct-Dec 00) Progress Report as required per Section D, Module IV, of the Cannon Air Force Base Resource Conservation and Recovery Act (RCRA) Part B Permit, Hazardous and Solid Waste Amendments Section.

Activities for the RCRA Corrective Action Program (RCAP) and other significant permit activities for the fourth quarter are as follows:

- a. Cannon AFB held a public meeting on the Class 3 Permit Modification Request and Restoration Advisory Board meeting on 26 Oct 00 at Cannon AFB.
- b. Cannon AFB sent representatives to the New Mexico Environment Department (NMED) Environmental Indicator Class on 14 Nov 00 and the NMED/DOD Partnering Meeting on 15 Nov 00.
- c. Cannon AFB sent proof of publication to NMED of the public meeting notice for the Class 3 Permit Modification request.
- d. Cannon AFB contractors gave a presentation to NMED on the results of the Corrective Measures Study for closure of the sewage lagoons.
- e. Cannon AFB contractors completed most of the construction work on the surface cleanup of Landfill 25. All exposed asbestos containing material was removed and disposed of off base and the concrete rubble was picked up and crushed. The surface will be revegetated in the Spring.

Projected RCAP activities for the first quarter of 2001 are as follows:

a. Cannon AFB will submit the Corrective Measures Study Report for the Sewage Lagoons (SWMU 101). It was anticipated that this report would be sent in the fourth quarter of 2000 but NMED requested a few revisions after it was presented.

b. Cannon AFB will submit the Corrective Measures Study Report for Fire Training Area 4 (SWMUs 109-112). This report was anticipated to be submitted in the fourth quarter of 2000 but has been delayed.

c. Cannon AFB will submit draft Statement of Basis Document for the Class 3 Permit Modification Request.

d. Cannon AFB will submit a groundwater monitoring report for well R at Landfill 25.

e. Cannon AFB will send NMED a copy of the current Management Action Plan which presents the schedule for IRP sites.
