SUBJECT: Restoration Advisory Board Quarterly Meeting

1. The quarterly meeting of the Restoration Advisory Board (RAB) was called to order at Clovis Community College by Col Bowen. He welcomed all members and thanked them for their attendance. Col Bowen turned the meeting over to Mr. John Pike at 1900 on 1 Mar 01. Attendance is reflected in attachment 2.

2. Old Business. The minutes of 26 Oct 00 RAB meeting were approved.

3. New Business.

a. Mr. Pike discussed the various restoration sites undergoing work on Cannon Air Force Base. He first discussed Fire Training Pit 4.


b. Mr. Pike also reviewed actions at the base's Sewage Lagoons. This site was used for Cannon's wastewater until 1998. The Corrective Measures Study (CMS) is expected to be complete in March with field work beginning in June. The lagoons will be filled with crushed concrete from the remains of Landfill 25 for final closure.

c. Site SD-11, the old jet engine test site, was discussed. The report is due final in April 01. The soil boring was completed January of this year, and results are being compiled.

d. Landfill 25 was highlighted as Cannon's most rewarding cleanup thus far. Before and after pictures were shown. Mr. Pike stated that the recycling of 24,000 tons of concrete and 72,000 pounds of scrap metal saved the base over 700,000 dollars on disposal costs. This effort will save the Air Force nearly \$1.7 million. After the presentation by Mr. Pike, he directed the meeting towards the Landfill 25 Display.

e. The meeting then opened to comment. One member from the Clovis Community asked Public Affairs, Lt Healy, to print an article highlighting the efforts at Landfill 25. The group addressed further areas where further advertisement and public release would be beneficial.

4. The next RAB meeting will be scheduled in July on Cannon Air Force Base. The particular date, time and location will be determined later so they have minimal conflict with other community activities.


