This letter is the fourth quarter (Oct-Dec 01) Progress Report as required per Section D, Module IV, of the Cannon Air Force Base Resource Conservation and Recovery Act (RCRA) Part B Permit, Hazardous and Solid Waste Ammendments Section.

Activities for the RCRA Corrective Action Program (RCAP) and other significant permit activities for the fourth quarter of 2001 are as follows:

- a. Cannon AFB took ground water samples at Replacement Monitoring Well 'R' Landfill 25 (SWMU 97) and Monitoring Well 'N', Landfill 4 (SWMU 104) and Monitoring Well 'O', Landfill 3 (SWMU 105).

Projected RCAP activities for the first quarter of 2002 are as follows:

- b. Cannon AFB will initiate remedial activity at the Sewage Lagoons (SWMU 101) and at Fire Training Area 4 (SWMUs 109, 110, 111, and 112).
- c. Cannon AFB will hold a RAB meeting in Feb 02.

Activities for the RCRA Corrective Action Program (RCAP) and other significant permit activities for the fourth quarter of 2001 are as follows:


- a. Cannon AFB took a well depth measurement at the OB/OD monitoring well.
