This letter is the first quarter (Jan-Mar 02) Progress Report as required per Section D, Module IV, of the Cannon Air Force Base Resource Conservation and Recovery Act (RCRA) Part B Permit, Hazardous and Solid Waste Ammendments Section.

Activities for the RCRA Corrective Action Program (RCAP) and other significant permit activities for the first quarter of 2002 are as follows:

- a. Cannon AFB submitted to New Mexico Environment Department (NMED) reports for annual and semi-annual ground water monitoring results for samples taken at Replacement Monitoring Well 'R' Landfill 25 (Solid Waste Management Unit [SWMU] 97), Monitoring Wells B, C, D, S, T, U and Q Landfill 5 (SWMU 113), and Monitoring Wells E, F, G, and H Sewage Lagoon (SWMU 101).
- b. Cannon AFB submitted to NMED for review and approval the Corrective Measures Study (CMS) Report for SWMUs 109, 110, 111 and 112-Fire Training Area Four (FTA-4).
- c. Cannon AFB held a Restoration Advisory Board (RAB) Meeting on 28 Feb 02 at the base Civil Engineering Squadron.
- d. Cannon AFB sumitted to NMED the annual evaluation of the bioventing soil remediation at SWMU #70, Oil/Water Separator No. 326 at Cannon Air Force Base. This report presents the results of the soil-gas samples collected at the site August 21-22, 2001.

Projected RCAP activities for the second quarter of 2002 are as follows:

- e. Cannon AFB will initiate remedial activity at the Sewage Lagoons (SWMU 101) and FTA-4 (SWMUs 109, 110, 111 and 112), pending NMED approval of revised CMS.

f. Cannon AFB will hold a RAB meeting on 13 Jun 02.
