This letter is the third quarter (Jul-Sep 02) Progress Report as required per Section D, Module IV, of the Cannon Air Force Base Resource Conservation and Recovery Act (RCRA) Part B Permit, Hazardous and Solid Waste Ammendments Section.

Activities for the RCRA Corrective Action Program (RCAP) and other significant permit activities for the third quarter of 2002 are as follows:

- a. Restoration Advisory Board (RAB) Meeting was held on 26 Sep at Cannon AFB. The meeting was highlighted by a tour of three SWMU's at the base and the new data collection well for monitoring aquifer depth.
- b. Cannon AFB staff reviewed the Defense-State Memorandum of Agreement Annual Report
- c. Cannon AFB participated in the Federal Facilities Partnership Meeting in Albuquerque on 28 Aug.
- d. Mr. Denny Timmons and Mr. Pete Zamie attended Risk Based Corrective Action training at Holloman AFB 9-11 Jul.
- e. Cannon AFB provided your office two copies of the Final Revised Long-Term Monitoring Work Plan (LTMWP) for ERP Sites Nos. LF-03 (SWMU 105), LF-04 (SWMU 104), and LF-25 (SWMU 97) located at Cannon Air Force Base (CAFB), Clovis, New Mexico. This LTMWP supports the following fieldwork being performed at CAFB:

(1) The annual (2002) sampling of groundwater wells at LF-03 (well O), LF-04 (well N) and the semi-annual sampling of groundwater at LF-25 (well Ra).

(2) The development of a Groundwater Monitoring Report for the 2002 sampling events.

Projected RCAP activities for the fourth quarter of 2002: Cannon AFB held a kick-off teleconference on 9 Oct 02 with the contractor and the Corps of Engineers to initiate remedial activity at the Sewage Lagoons (SWMU 101).
