SUBJECT: Restoration Advisory Board Quarterly Meeting

1. The quarterly meeting of the Restoration Advisory Board (RAB) was called to order on 23 Jan at 1900 in the conference room of the Memorial Building, Portales, NM. RAB Co-Chair's Col Scott Showers and Mr. Chris Harrell welcomed all members. All members approved the minutes of the previous RAB. Attendance is reflected in attachment 2.

2. Installation Restoration Program Update.

a. Final Corrective Measures Study (CMS) Report – Fire Training Area 4 (FTA-4). Cannon briefed NMED on 26 Sep 02 about the proposed CMS at the site. NMED will determine if the report is administratively complete and determine what the fee will be. Ms. Jacobs stated that Glenn Von Gonten has determined it is technically complete.

b. Sewage Lagoons. Four proposed bidders performed a pre bid site visit on 10 Dec 02, bids were received on 30 Dec 02 and a selection will be made on 24 Jan. The Corps of Engineers feel our concern with the a cover material may already be addressed. Foster Wheeler, the prime contractor, thought that bidders would have a source for material locally, instead of hauling material from the Taiban Pit.

c. Groundwater Study at CAFB and MAFR. The preliminary US Geological Survey study for groundwater shows that the Mesa has higher variations in major ions and trace elements than the wells farther away which have a consistent make-up. The new 330' deep well samples are much different from the 125' wells. The final report hasn't been received at this time and more detailed results will be discussed at the next meeting.

d. MAFR Request for Information (RFI). In 1997 NMED requested additional soil sampling and an Ecological Risk Assessment. Sampling was completed in Jun 02. A draft addendum was received in Oct 02, reviewed and sent to Foster-Wheeler with comments. We are awaiting the final addendum.

e. No Further Action (NFA) Sites. Waiting on preliminary review from NMED on 66 NFA sites. It is expected that approximately a third will be approved, with others needing additional justification and some not approved. NMED will complete the review soon. Ms. Jacobs concurred with the information as briefed and stated that Mr. von Gonten is working on this now.

3. The next RAB meeting is tentatively scheduled for 22 May 03 in Clovis. The particular time will be determined later so they have minimal conflict with other community activities.
