This letter is the first quarter of CY03 (Jan-Mar) Progress Report as required per Section D, Module IV, of the Cannon Air Force Base Resource Conservation and Recovery Act (RCRA) Part B Permit, Hazardous and Solid Waste Amendments Section.

Activities for the RCRA Corrective Action Program (RCAP) and other significant permit activities for the first quarter of CY03 are as follows:

- a. The Final Work Plan for the Sewage Lagoon (SWMU 101) was completed in mid-January and copies were sent to your office.
- b. A Restoration Advisory Board (RAB) was held at 7:00 pm, 23 Jan at the Memorial Building in Portales, NM.
- c. Two additional copies of the Corrective Measures Study (CMS) for Site SD-11 (SWMU's 86-90), Final Report dated Jul 99, and two copies of an Addendum to the CMS dated 25 Jul 01 were delivered to your office 4 Mar.
- d. Ground water samples were collected at SWMU 113, Landfill 5 and Cell 3.
- e. Analytical results of RCRA Ground Water Monitoring sampling from Aug 02 were delivered to CAFB in Feb 03.
- f. Foster Wheeler Environmental Corp and subcontractor Arrowhead Contracting of Overland Park, KS began work on the closure of SWMU 101, Sewage Lagoons on 6 Mar.

Projected RCAP activities for the second quarter of CY03 are as follows:

- a. A RAB meeting is scheduled for 22 May at the Clovis-Carver Public Library meeting room.
- b. Work will continue on SWMU 101 closure.
- c. Groundwater level/sampling will be collected for evaluation from Landfills 03, 04 and 25 from wells "N", "O", "P" and "Ra".
