SUBJECT: Restoration Advisory Board (RAB) Meeting Minutes




Cannon AFB Restoration Update



- Corrective Measures Implementation - SWMU 101 (Sewage Lagoons)
- NFA Proposals
- Hazardous Waste Permit
- Future First Planning (F2P)
- Fuels Area Soil Sampling

Sewage Lagoons



- Project under construction with Tetra-Tech Foster Wheeler and the Corps of Engineers
 - Subcontractor is Arrowhead Construction, Overland Park, KS
 - Cost is \$2,662,103.14
 - Construction started March 10, 2003
 - Construction complete July 2004

Status of NFA Sites



- NFA site determination completed by NMED
 - 35 sites appear to be ready
 - 21 sites may qualify with additional documentation
 - 29 sites need additional investigation or have documents awaiting review by NMED
 - NMED Reviewing proposal for 35 sites



Hazardous Waste Permit Application



- **Renewal of 1989 permit under Hazardous and Solid Waste Amendment (HSWA)**
 - HSWA Module only
 - Temporary Storage Facility Closed
 - Permit Approved



Future First Planning




- **Test Cell Administrative Building**
 - Environmental cleanup of site SD-11 (fuels)
 - Relocates Bldg 2330 outside of the taxiway clear zone
 - Funds made available for Customer Concept Document (CCD) in June
 - CCD provides about a 35 percent design
 - Preliminary costs are \$2.5M for clean up of SD-11 and \$1.4M for new facility

Fuels Area



- Relocation of existing offloading stations requires a clean site
 - Soil testing done to see if clean up needed before construction starts
- Existing area also sampled to determine extent of cleanup needed as part of demolition of old facility
