CANNON AFB, NM, DEFENSIVE TRAINING INITIATIVE OPERATIONS

Dear Chief Bearzi:

I have heard nothing from your office regarding chaff and flare canisters deployed upon our private property ranch here in DeBaca County, New Mexico, USA. Would you like more data or more pictures of accumulation of trash from the USAF?

I would be glad to come to Santa Fe and show you the trash/litter and documentation with fraudulent statements allowing the Air Force to condemn our private property, a violation of our FIFTH AMENDMENT, UNITED STATES CONSTITUTION.

The Air Force is known to lie and stall. One of my damage claims resulting from the 9 SEP 2002 crash within one mile of my house is just now being paid, noted 29 APRIL 2005, yet I have yet to receive it some four months after settlement was received at Cannon AFB.

Please advise if you need more information or possible visit to your office. Our property rights and New Mexico Law is being bastardized without any apparent response from various New Mexico departments.
