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

Cannon AFB requests a 180-day extension to the requirement in Comment 7 of your letter of 19 Jul 05, Cannon AFB – Corrective Measures Study for Site SD-11 (SWMUs 86-90), EPA ID NO. NM7572124454, HWB-CAFB-03-001, stating that "CAFB shall submit a work plan within 90 days of the receipt of this letter." The current requirement sets the due date at 19 Oct 05 which is not enough time to obtain funding, have the work plan prepared and staff the final package. We are attempting to obtain funding to retain a consultant to accomplish the work plan. The Base Realignment and Closure recommendations by the Department of Defense have placed funding on hold for work at Cannon and we will have to get waivers to expend funding for the preparation of this document.
