SUBJECT: Restoration Advisory Board (RAB) Meeting Minutes, 9 Feb 06

1. The Restoration Advisory Board was held on 9 Feb 06 at 7:00 pm. The RAB was called to order by Lt Col Jim Lewis, the Co-Chair of the Restoration Advisory Board, who then turned the meeting over to Mr. Pete Zamie. Attendance is reflected in attachment 1.

2. A copy of the slides used for the RAB meeting is at attachment 2.

3. **Reports:**

a. Long term monitoring at Landfills 3, 4 and 25 continues. All FY05 sampling has been completed.

b. Status of NFA Sites. 34 Solid Waste Management Units (SWMUs) are ready to be removed from the Cannon AFB permit. Public comment period ended 13 Feb 06. Awaiting NMED's approval to modify our permit in deleting the 34 SMWUs in question.


c. No changes to Areas-of-Concern A/B/C, and SD-11 (SMWUs 86-90).

d. New NMED FEE Structure has been negotiated. The Hazardous Waste Bureau has requested a hearing with the NM Environmental Improvement Board in March but more than likely will be this summer.

4. **Old Business:** Mr. Fred Gebhardt of the United States Geological Survey provided historical water level information on Sampling Well "B" and will be including more information on additional wells in an upcoming report. (CLOSED)

5. **New Business:** There was no new business presented at the meeting.

6. The meeting adjourned at 8:15 pm. The next meeting is tentatively scheduled for Jun 06 in Portales.



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

FY 06 Projects



- Long Term Monitoring at Landfills 3, 4 and 25
 - Falls under Performance Based Management
 - Transferred from Omaha COE to AFCEE
 - HGL is again using BHATE Environmental Engineers and Scientists to perform the sampling
 - FY 05 sampling completed



Status of NFA Sites



- NFA site determination completed by NMED
 - 34 Solid Waste Management Units (SWMUs) are ready to be removed from the permit
 - 21 SWMUs qualify with additional documentation
 - Final Work Plan under review
 - Consultant performing further investigation to prepare permit modification documentation
 - ECD Mar 06



Status of NFA Sites



- 29 SWMUs need additional investigation or have documents awaiting review by NMED



Status of Other Sites



- Areas-of-Concern "A", "B" and "C"
 - Work Plan and investigation completed
 - Awaiting Final Report and Permit Modification Request document
 - NMED still has not provided comments on this plan
- SD-11 (SWMUs 86-90)
 - NMED completed review of the 1999 Corrective Measures Study and requested a Work Plan that addresses their comments
 - The Work Plan for Corrective Measures Implementation (CMI) originally due 19 Oct 05; 180-day + extension granted to 30 Apr 06
 - URS, Corp has prepared draft of work plan for our review



Future First Planning



- Test Cell Support Facility
 - Environmental cleanup of site SD-11 (fuels)
 - Current working estimate is \$900K for clean up of SD-11
 - Facility Relocation
 - Relocates Bldg 2330 outside of the taxiway clear zone
 - Programmed amount is \$695K for new facility
 - Project facility design on hold at 35 percent



Part 3 Permit Modification



- 34 SWMU NFA Review completed by NMED
 - NMED placed legal notice in Albuquerque Journal 28 Dec 05
 - 45 Day comment period ends 13 Feb 06
 - NMED intends to approve pending public input to the decision to modify Cannon's permit



NMED Fee Structure



- NMED proposed new fee regulation in Sep 04
 - Meetings held with state and federal agencies; private organizations were also invited
 - Oct 04
 - Oct 05
 - Nov 05
 - Dec 05
 - Jan 06
 - Attendees and NMED negotiated regulation and fee structure
 - The Hazardous Waste Bureau will request a hearing from the NM Environmental Improvement Board in March
 - Hearing will probably take place this summer
 - We will be invited to attend and provide comment if any


