



SUBJECT: Restoration Advisory Board (RAB) Meeting Minutes, 22 Jun 06



1. The Restoration Advisory Board was held on 22 Jun 06 at 7:00 pm. The RAB was called to order by Col Margaret Poore, the Co-Chair of the Restoration Advisory Board, who then turned the meeting over to Mr. Peter P. Zamie. Attendance is reflected in attachment 1.
2. A copy of the slides used for the RAB meeting is at attachment 2.
3. **Reports:**
 - a. Long-term monitoring at Landfills 3, 4, and 25 continues. All FY05 sampling has been completed with negative findings.
 - b. Status of NFA Sites. The removal of 34 Solid Waste Management Units (SWMUs) from the Cannon AFB permit has been approved by NMED and will occur 31 Dec 06.
 - c. No changes to Areas-of-Concern A/B/C, and the remediation of SD-11 (SWMUs 86-90) has been funded with work to commence in Aug 06.
 - d. New NMED FEE Structure has been negotiated. The NM Environmental Improvement Board reviewed and approved the fee structure 7 Jun 06. The new fees will become effective in Aug 06.
4. **Old Business:** There was no old business presented at the meeting.
5. **New Business:** There was no new business presented at the meeting.
6. The meeting adjourned at 7:20 pm. The next meeting is tentatively scheduled for Oct 06 in Portales.





Cannon AFB Restoration Update

- FY 06 Projects
- NFA Proposals

FY 06 Projects

- Long Term Monitoring at Landfills 3, 4 and 25
 - Falls under Performance Based Management
 - HydroGeoLogic is again using BHATE Environmental Engineers and Scientists to perform the sampling
 - FY 05 sampling completed with negative findings
 - Met with NMED on 15 Jun to discuss NFA for these sites

FY 06 Projects

- Environmental cleanup of site SD-11 (fuels)
 - Project awarded 18 May 06 for \$467.6K
 - Probably start work in August 06
 - SD-11 (SWMUs 86-90)
 - NMED completed review of the 1999 Corrective Measures Study and requested a Work Plan that addresses their comments⁶
 - The Work Plan was submitted to NMED on 27 Mar 06

Status of NFA Sites

- NFA site determination completed by NMED
 - 34 Solid Waste Management Units (SWMUs) have been approved for removal from the permit on 31 Dec 06
 - 21 SWMUs qualify with additional documentation
 - Field work completed
 - Report preparation underway
 - ECD Aug 06

Status of NFA Sites


- 29 SWMUs need additional investigation or have documents awaiting review by NMED

Status of Other Sites

- Areas-of-Concern "A", "B" and "C"
 - Work Plan and investigation completed
 - Awaiting Final Report and Permit Modification Request document
 - NMED still has not provided comments on this plan

Annual Unit Audit

- NMED has sent the preliminary AUA for our concurrence and will invoice us 01 Oct
 - The number of units has not been decreased as yet since the audit covers the units that were on the permit in 2005
 - We will be billed for the new, lower number of units next year

NMED Fee Structure

- NMED proposed new fee regulation in Sep 04
 - Meetings held with state and federal agencies; private organizations were also invited
 - Oct 04
 - Oct 05
 - Nov 05
 - Dec 05
 - Jan 06
 - Attendees and NMED negotiated regulation and fee structure
 - The Hazardous Waste Bureau requested a hearing from the NM Environmental Improvement Board in March
 - Hearing was held 7 Jun in Hobbs, NM
 - New Fee Schedule approved
 - Invoice will probably be delayed until 01 Oct 06
