
The New Mexico Environment Department (NMED) has completed its review of Cannon Air Force Base's (the Permittee) *Site SD-11 Corrective Measures Implementation Work Plan*, dated February 2006. The Permittee does not propose specific activities for removal of contaminated media at Site SD-11 in the plan. In NMED's July 19, 2005 letter, NMED intended for the Permittee to submit a work plan describing procedures to remove the remaining contaminated soil at Site SD-11.

Within ninety (90) days of receipt of this letter, the Permittee must submit a work plan for NMED approval describing proposed activities to remove all soils containing petroleum related hydrocarbon concentrations above 2350 mg/kg (see Table 2b of NMED's TPH Screening Guidelines, November 2005).
